Pastor's Report

- •Sunday School room updates continue to be worked on.
- •Sunday School Christmas Program is set for December 15 at 10 a.m.
- •Will work on a Parent Sunday School Update letter to send home since there is no Superintendent this year.

Old Business

•Parsonage window and paint repair from hail damage was discussed. Insurance Company said they would re-open the claim.

M/S/P to have the exterior of the parsonage painted by Vogel Painting and replace the broken window.

- •The Call Committee has been meeting. They have reached out to possible candidates with not a lot of response. Emails are being sent out to all states. Will continue to market the church with the "possibility of becoming a two-point parish" if needed.
- •No one has stepped forward to direct the Bell Choir. At this time no action will take place and it will be taken off the agenda.
- •Church Auction will be Sunday, October 13 right after the worship service. To-Go Lunches will be available right after the worship service.

New Business

- •Sue Hendrickson shared with the Council the plans to re-open the thrift store in Springfield. A group of volunteers is working on the project and just wanted the church to know of the plans.
- •Saw Works will be submitting a bid for snow removal for the church and parsonage properties. They have done it the past few years and have the proper equipment to complete the job.
- •M/S/P to have a Thanksgiving Eve Service Wednesday, November 27 at 7:00 p.m. St. Johns will be invited to join us. There will be a potluck dessert social following the service.
- •M/S/P to have the Sunday School Christmas Program on Sunday, December 15 at 10:00 a.m.
- •M/S/P to not have a Christmas Day Worship Service.
- •M/S/P to have the Christmas Eve Service. Time TBD..... depending on the pastor situation with St. Johns Church as Pastor Carl would have to cover both.
- •Springfield Ministerium is planning a Community Ecumenical Thanksgiving Service Sunday, November 24 at the Springfield Area Community Center. Time TBD.



- •The Thanksgiving Basket account has a \$2,926.44 balance. We will do baskets again this year. Katie will organize for Sunday, November 24 but will need help packing and delivering. Nominations will be accepted for the basket recipients.
- •SW Minnesota Men's Chorus will do their Christmas Concert at St. Johns Church rather than St. Paul's this year—just to change up the venue. It will be on Monday, December 9.
