St. Paul Lutheran Church Council Meeting-September 13, 2023

The September meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Room 101 at the church. Present were Jo Muske, Randy Wendt, Tim Vogel, Kathy Pederson, Denise Gicker, John Mueller, Jacob Marz and Jeff Krueger. Sarah Groebner was absent. Katie Mueller, Parish Coordinator, and Anita Jensen, Financial Secretary, were also present.

Chairman John led the group in prayer.

M/S/P to approve the August Secretary's Report as presented.

M/S/P to approve the Financial Report as printed and pay the August benevolence.

Building and Grounds

- •Still waiting for Brown Tree Service to come and remove the stump from the tree taken down at the bottom of the ramp.
- •Jeremy Zihlke examined the plexiglass coverings on the stained glass windows. He believes just the broken one needs to be fixed and he will submit a quote for that repair.
- •Jeremy Zihlke also looked at the space under the ramp. He suggested some spray foam to help alleviate the dampness in the space.
- •The parsonage was discussed in preparing it for an interim and new pastor. Jan Kratz did a thorough cleaning of the entire house and Al Groebner is working on cleaning up the landscaping outside. The carpet will need to be replaced or laminate flooring laid and air ducts cleaned due to past pet issues. M/S/P to have the Building and Grounds Committee make decisions on those items and get back to the council.

The living room was also repainted to a neutral color.

- •Looking for a couch and chair/recliner to furnish the parsonage for the interim pastor. Will advertise in the church bulletin.
- •Tim brought up the new sound/video system—still having some issues with it. Company will be back to help resolve the issues. Bill will not be paid until issues are resolved and is working correctly.
- •Jeff reported there had been some organ issues and the organ tuning company came out to resolve them. It was a simple fix and they tuned the organ while they were here (usually done in November). They also suggested that the organ blower (in boiler room) should soon be replaced and that may be what is causing organ issues in the colder months.
- •Discussion on cleaning and maintenance in the church building.

Parish Education

- •Rally Sunday was held September 10 in Riverside Park with St. Johns Lutheran Church. Approximately 175 worshipped and enjoyed the event.
- •Sunday School will begin September 17. Fifty-five students are registered for Sunday School this year. Still looking for a teacher for the first-second grade classroom.
- •Cradle Doves and Catechism presentations will be made on September 17 during the 9 a.m. worship service. Third grade Bibles and Preschool Bibles will be presented on September 24.

Old Business

•Reviewed resumes and contracts for our interim pastor. Pastor Carl Billings and Pastor Patrick Hall submitted them to the church. M/S/P to approve a contract with Pastor Carl Billings to serve as our Intentional Interim Pastor beginning in

October. He has some specific ideas for going forward to call a new pastor that he will review with the council at the October meeting.

New Business

- •M/S/P to hold our Fall German Supper on Wednesday, October 25. Will have dine in, take out or drive up options available. Planning to serve 575. Ticket prices will be \$14.00 in advance and \$15.00 at the door.
- •Discussed St. Paul's representation on St. John's Home Board of Directors. Pastor Tricia had been our representative. Jill Vogel will be asked to fill the vacancy.

M/S/P to adjourn at 9:20 p.m. We closed with the Lord's Prayer. Next meeting will be Wednesday, October 11, 2023 at 7:30 p.m.
